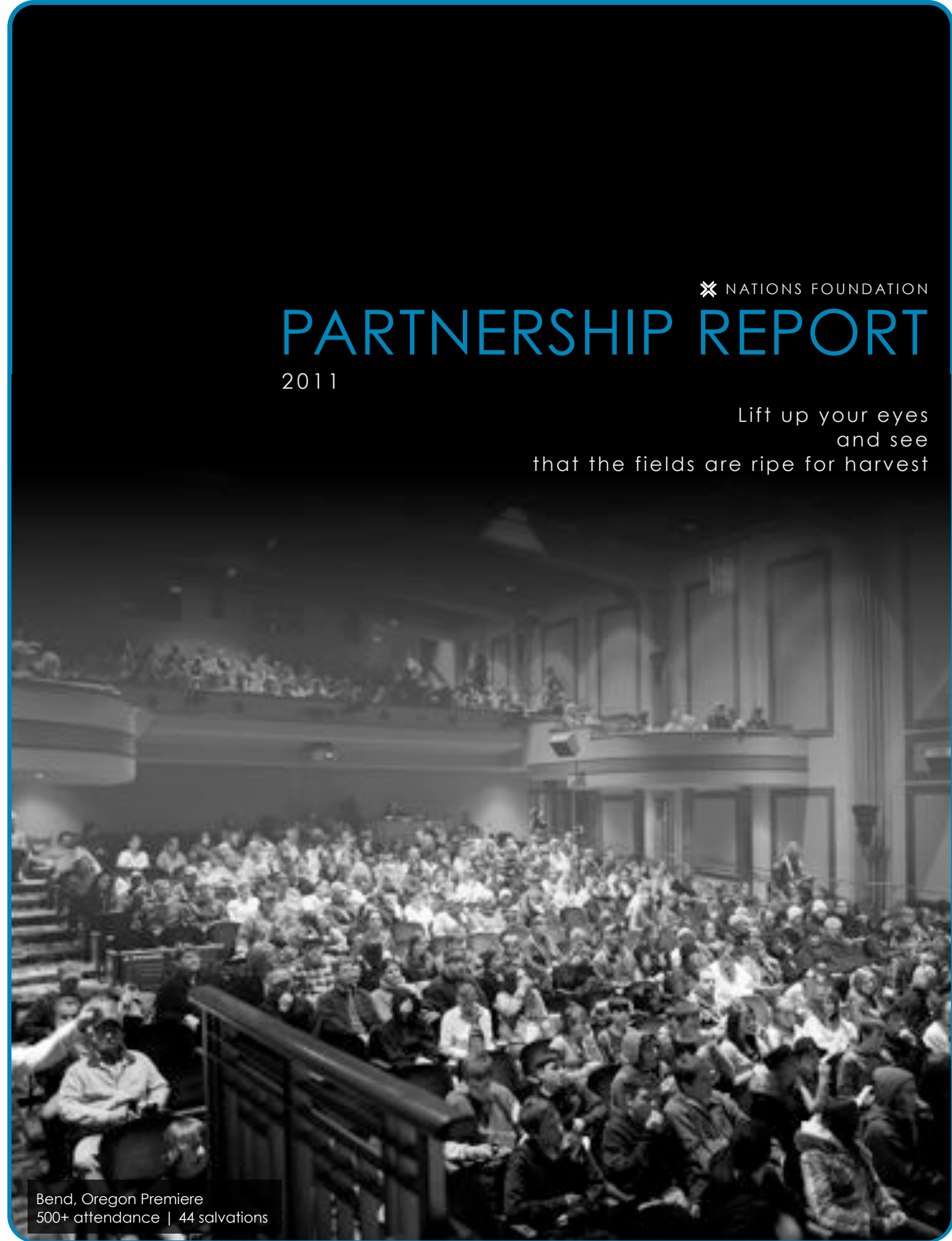

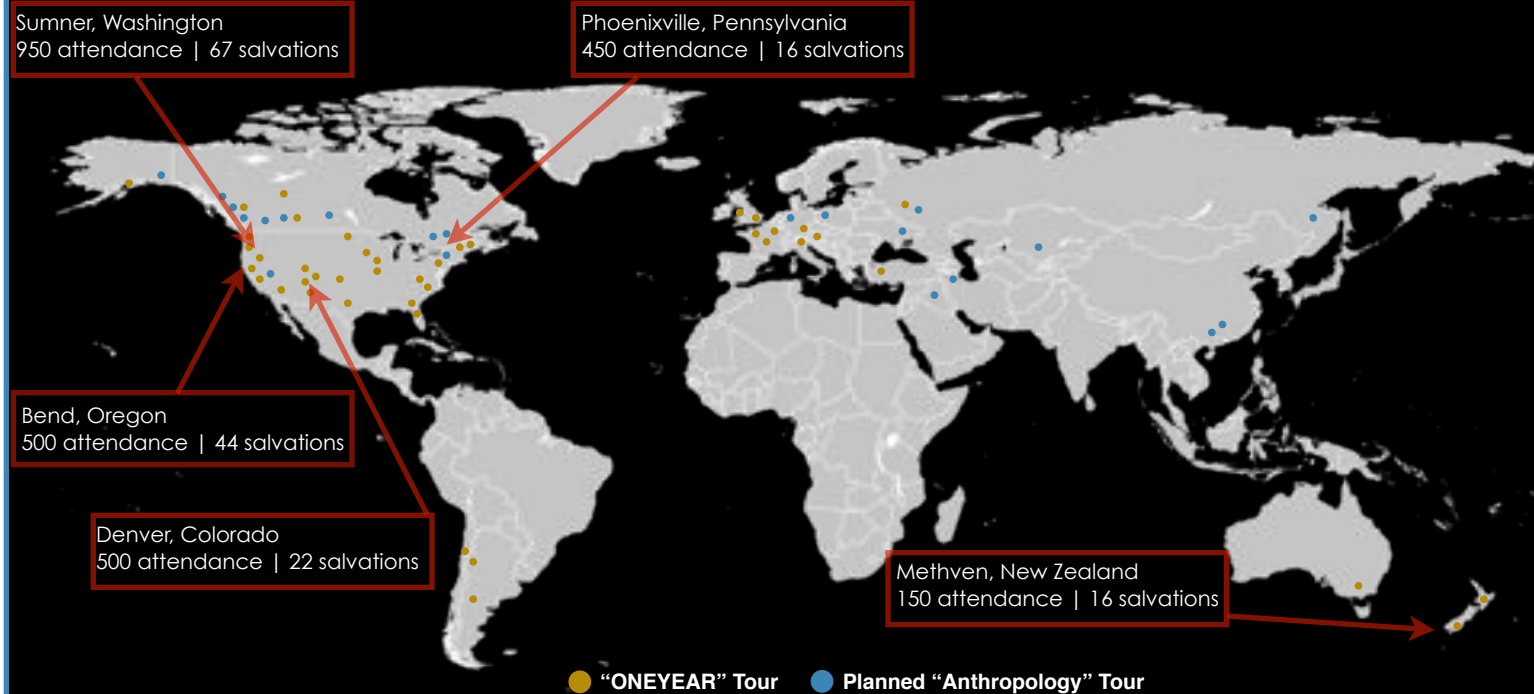

2 Year Vision [the next step]

For the last 3 years Nations Foundation has sought to reach and impact this generation with the saving message of Jesus Christ. We plan to continue this mission by releasing a second film that will present the gospel to the unreached demographic of youth. Since the release of our first film "ONEYEAR", the gospel has been presented to roughly 100,000 people all around the world. We do not want to end there! Now that the foundation has been laid, we feel that the potential for a second film could reach 250,000 around the world. We know we have a voice with the lost and we plan to continue to share Christ and His plan for salvation.

The "Anthropology" tour will revisit each location that "ONEYEAR" premiered at as well as focus on new markets like Korea, Japan, China, Eastern Europe, Russia, as well as Iran and Kyrgyzstan. We will be working with Luis Palau's team in Europe and South America to maximize impact as well as Young Life and Campus Crusade For Christ in the United States and Canada. We are working on partnering with other ministries to continue to reach this generation with the Gospel. We feel that evangelism works best by operating **with, through, & for** the local church. By partnering with the local church and other ministries the gospel can advance at a rapid pace!

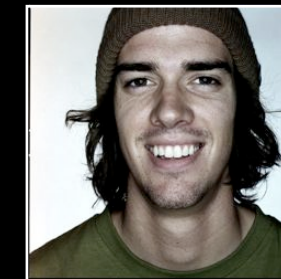

This documentary will be a spiritual coming of age for Nick and will allow the audience to participate in a 40 minute discipleship relationship with the heroes of snowboarding.
